- Violations of CIGAR products sold to minors represent $46 \%$ of all violations.
- Violations of CIGARETTES IN A PACKAGE products sold to minors represent more than $22 \%$ of all violations.
- Violations of ENDS/E-liquid products sold to minors represent less than $26 \%$ of all violations
- Violations of SMOKELESS TOBACCO products sold to minors represent less than $1 \%$ of all violations
- Violations of SINGLE CIGARETTE products (LOOSIES) represent $0.30 \%$ of all violations


## Important Unknowns about the pubicly available FDA enforcement Data

An Important 'unknown' are the Products and Brands associated with the 39,515 compliance checks with NO VIOLATIONS. In other words, the data is not available, and therefore, we don't know if one product type or another (or brand) is associated with higher or lower NO VIOLATIONS.

- FDA has indicated (in We Card's Sept 20, 2018 meeting with FDA CTP Director and CTP staff), that it is left up to the States (who sub-contract with FDA to perform the compliance checks) to decide what Products and which Brands are requested by the minors involved in the compliance checks. Therefore, the Products and Brands requested by minors may vary widely amongst the states. We Card is aware that some states specify to the minors what products and brands to attempt to purchase and others do not.
